CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – April 2009

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 11,059 in March to 11,066 in April. The **Average Daily Population decreased slightly** from 9,035 to 8,986. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in April (6,152) compared to March (6,265). The **Sentenced Population increased** to 2,442 in April compared to 2,365 in March. **Agency Hold Populations decreased** from 345 in March to 331 in April. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** in April from 26.3 days to 25.2 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 22.6 to 24; while the **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 67 to 61. **Pretrial ALOS stayed the same** at 6.3.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings decreased from March (3,508) to April (3,111). **Terminations decreased** to 3,067 in April from 3,563 in March. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 98.6%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,522 in March to 11,214 in April. **Filings into RCC decreased** in April (1,795) compared to March (2,045). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,220 in March to 1,061 in April. **The Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 101 in March to 86 in April. **The Trial Rate** was 2.8%.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings increased from March (4,853) to April (5,172). **Overall Filings decreased** from March (34,855) to April (34,060).


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased from March (581) to April (584). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased slightly**, from 1,057 in March to 1,062 in April. **Electronic Monitoring increased slightly** from 268 in March to 270 in April. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from (29,974) in March to (29,616) in April; **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision also decreased** from 969 in March to 923 in April.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) decreased** from 318 in March to 291 in April. ADP is down 16% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS increased** from 12.4 days to 13.6 days. ALOS is down 10% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC decreased** from 66 in March to 51 in April. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,290 in March to 4,220 in April. **Intensive Probation increased slightly** from 464 to 467.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates


Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances







Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments





Superior Court Trials Completed




Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Justice Court Filings April 2009








Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


