CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – April 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 8,717 in March to 8,831 in April.
- The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,367 in March to 7,528 in April.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 5,337 in March to 5,491 in April.
- The **Sentenced Population increased slightly** from 1,811 in March to 1,815 in April.
- The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 167 in March to 172 in April.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 25.1 days in March to 24.6 in April.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 23.8 days in March to 22.5 days in April.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial decreased** from 7.3 days in March to 6.95 days in April.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 67.7 days in March to 71.4 days in April.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,968 in March to 2,685 in April.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,908 in March to 2,983 in April.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 111%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,033 in March to 11,251 in April.
- **Filings into Regional Court Center decreased** from 1,546 in March to 1,418 in April.
- **Filings into Early Disposition Court decreased** from 1,140 in March to 942 in April.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 36 in March to 53 in April.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 653 in March to 590 in April.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,803 in March to 3,021 in April.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,947 in March to 9,243 in April.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 4,086 in March to 4,786 in April.
- **Overall Filings decreased** from 29,043 in March to 26,241 in April.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision decreased** from 1,803 in March to 1,648 in April.
- **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 378 in March to 374 in April.
- **Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,659 in March to 21,844 in April.
- **Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 732 in March to 689 in April.
- **Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 8,072 in March to 7,999 in April.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 229 in March to 250 in April.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 14.1 days in March to 12.1 in April.
- **Standard probation decreased** from 2,676 in March to 2,652 in April.
- **Intensive Probation decreased** from 280 in March to 268 in April.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 41 in March to 31 in April.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail



Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Status of Cases After 180 Days






Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments





Justice Court Filings April 2012




Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

- April 2012





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




Standard and Unsupervised Probation populations were reported jointly under Standard prior to the July 2011 version of this report.

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
