CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – August 2009

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 10,840 in July to 10,926 in August. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,604 to 8,464. The **Pretrial Population decreased slightly** in August (5,888) compared to July (6,000). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,204 in July to 2,196 in August. **Agency Hold Populations decreased** from 345 in July to 321 in August. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 25.5 days in July to 23.8 days in August. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased slightly** from 24.9 to 23.8 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased slightly** from 57.7 to 57.1 days. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.2 to 6.7 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings decreased from July (2,907) to August (2,864). **Terminations increased** from 2,658 in July to 2,848 in August. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 99.4%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased slightly** from 11,886 in July to 11,835 in August. **Filings into RCC increased** in August (1,805) compared to July (1,727). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 966 in July to 755 in August. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 60 in July to 70 in August. **The Trial Rate** was 2.4%.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings decreased from July (6,243) to August (5,947). **Overall Filings** in August were 68,280 including 34,460 filings from Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased slightly from July (539) to August (540). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 980 in July to 929 in August. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 246 in July to 245 in August. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 29,618 in July to 30,181 in August. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 832 in July to 841 in August.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) decreased** from 274 in July to 237 in August. **ALOS decreased slightly** from 14.7 to 12.0 days. **Commitments to ADJC increased slightly** from 47 in June to 53 in July. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 405 to 400. **Standard probation decreased slightly** from 4,139 in July to 4,106 in August.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



Direct Filing began in May 2002




Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter




Grand Jury Indictments






Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


