CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – August 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 9,732 in July to 9,888 in August. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,482 in July to 7,405 in August. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in August (5,154) compared to July (5,165). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,005 in July to 1,946 in August. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 261 in July to 252 in August. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from July (23) to August (25). **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 24.7 to 25.6 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased slightly** from 5.5 to 5.7 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 60 to 67 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from July (2,504) to August (2,765). **Terminations decreased** from 2,809 in July to 2,747 in August. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 99%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,225 in July to 10,145 in August. **Filings into RCC increased** in August (1,638) compared to July (1,557). **Filings into EDC increased** from 779 in July to 950 in August. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 51 in July to 53 in August. **The Trial Rate** was 1.9%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings decreased slightly from July (858) to August (827). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,808 in July to 3,434 in August. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,324 in July to 9,739 in August. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from July (6,112) to August (6,217). **Overall Filings decreased** from 107,149 in July to 32,579 in August, with the large decrease attributable to the end of the civil traffic photo enforcement program.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased slightly from July (559) to August (553). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 805 in July to 827 in August. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 193 in July to 187 in August. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,575 in July to 30,476 in August. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 810 in July to 780 in August.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 245 in July to 202 in August. **ALOS decreased** from 14.7 to 12.5 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 27 in July to 31 in August. **Standard probation decreased slightly** from 3,771 in July to 3,765 in August. **Intensive Probation increased slightly** from 370 in July to 372 in August.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments




Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

- July-Aug 2010




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


