### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – August 2011*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings increased** from 9,001 in July to 9,404 in August. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,330 in July to 7,395 in August. The **Pretrial Population increased** from July (5,148) to August (5,264). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 1,862 in July to 1,843 in August. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 261 in July to 232 in August. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from July (24.5) to August (23.6). **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 26 to 24 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.5 to 6 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds stayed the same** at 62 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal Filings increased** from July (2,648) to August (2,948). **Terminations increased** from 2,681 in July to 3,095 in August. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 105%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased slightly** from 10,358 in July to 10,378 in August. **Filings into RCC increased** from July (1,478) to August (1,715). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 973 in July to 924 in August. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 45 in July to 58 in August. **The Trial Rate** was 2%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**DUI Filings decreased** from July (799) to August (762). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,290 in July to 3,839 in August. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 10,266 in July to 11,475 in August. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from July (6,004) to August (6,136). **Overall Filings increased** from 29,997 in July to 33,630 in August.


#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased** from July (550) to August (542). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased slightly** from 1,090 in July to 1,105 in August. **Electronic Monitoring increased slightly** from 224 in July to 229 in August. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,589 in July to 21,663 in August. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 771 in July to 742 in August. **Levels of Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 8,375 in July to 8,258 in August.


#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased slightly** from 213 in July to 218 in August. **ALOS stayed the same** at 12 days. **Standard probation decreased slightly** from 3,119 in July to 3,104 in August. **Intensive Probation increased** from 284 in July to 303 in August.




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

■ Cases Arraigned




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active      Awaiting sentence      Terminated




# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




# Grand Jury Indictments



## Average Monthly Filings by Quarter





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
