CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – February 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 8,880 in January to 8,204 in February.
- The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,362 in January to 7,387 in February.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 5,296 in January to 5,312 in February.
- The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,819 in January to 1,858 in February.
- The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 195 in January to 167 in February.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 25.3 days in January to 24.3 days in February.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 24.9 days in January to 26.2 days in February.
- The **Pretrial ALOS stayed the same** at 6.9 days.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 71 days in January to 64 days in February.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,768 in January to 2,626 in February.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 3,024 in January to 2,419 in February.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 92%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,014 in January to 11,098 in February.
- **Filings into Regional Court Center decreased** from 1,413 in January to 1,341 in February.
- **Filings into Early Disposition Court increased** from 1,153 in January to 1,018 in February.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 57 in January to 39 in February.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.5%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 1,098 in January to 619 in February.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,806 in January to 3,533 in February.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 11,069 in January to 10,331 in February.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 5,638 in January to 4,206 in February.
- **Overall Filings decreased** from 31,472 in January to 28,750 in February.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 1,864 in January to 1,886 in February.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 319 in January to 362 in February.
- **Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,612 in January to 21,656 in February.
- **Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 743 in January to 740 in February.
- **Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 8,299 in January to 8,075 in February.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 220 in January to 248 in February.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 12.3 days in January to 14.2 days in February.
- **Standard probation increased** from 2,661 in January to 2,677 in February.
- **Intensive Probation decreased** from 290 in January to 280 in February.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 41 in January to 35 in February.


Jail Bookings

Average Daily Jail Population by Type





Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

■ Active ■ Awaiting sentence ■ Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments


Justice Court Filings February 2012


Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

- Jan-Feb 2012





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
