CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – January 2012

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 7,792 in December to 8,880 in January. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,151 in December to 7,362 in January. The **Pretrial Population increased** from December (5,002) to January (5,296). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,689 in December to 1,819 in January. The **Agency Hold Population increased slightly** from 194 in December to 195 in January. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from December (27.3) to January (25.3). The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 29.6 to 24.9 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased slightly** from 7.0 to 6.9 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 72.5 to 71 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from December (2,658) to January (2,768). **Terminations increased** from 2,481 in December to 3,024 in January. The resulting **Clearance Rate was 109%**. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 10,995 in December to 11,014 in January. **Filings into RCC decreased** from December (1,478) to January (1,413). **Filings into EDC increased** from 886 in December to 1,153 in January. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 35 in December to 57 in January. The **Trial Rate was 2.1%**.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings increased from December (1,018) to January (1,098). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,335 in December to 3,806 in January. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 9,184 in December to 11,069 in January. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from December (5,258) to January (5,638). **Overall Filings increased** from 28,478 in December to 31,472 in January.

Adult Probation

Pretrial Standard* Supervision increased from 1,753 in December to 1,864 in January. **Electronic Monitoring stayed the same** with 319 in December and January. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,661 in December to 21,612 in January. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 737 in December to 743 in January. **Levels of Unsupervised Probation Supervision increased** from 8,279 in December to 8,299 in January.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 210 in December to 220 in January. **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 14.1 to 12.3 days. **Standard probation decreased** from 2,769 in December to 2,661 in January. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 294 in December to 290 in January. **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 26 in December to 41 in January.




Jail Bookings

Average Daily Jail Population by Type





Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

■ Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

■ Active ■ Awaiting sentence ■ Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments


Justice Court Filings January 2012


Average Monthly Filings by Quarter



Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




Standard and Unsupervised Probation populations were reported jointly under Standard prior to the July 2011 version of this report.

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
