CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – July 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 9,088 in June to 9,434 in July.
- The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,903 in June to 8,072 in July.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 5,790 in June to 6,048 in July.
- The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 1,907 in June to 1,811 in July.
- The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 158 in June to 166 in July.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 24.7 in June to 23.7 in July.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial increased** from 6.9 in June to 7.2 in July.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 24.9 in June to 25.7 in July.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 69.0 in June to 62.1 in July.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,755 in June to 2,731 in July.
- **Case Terminations decreased slightly** from 2,467 in June to 2,462 in July.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 90.2%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,412 in June to 11,767 in July.
- **Filings into Regional Court Center increased** from 1,512 in June to 1,636 in July.
- **Filings into Early Disposition Court decreased** from 966 in June to 839 in July.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 40 in June to 38 in July.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.4%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 787 in June to 834 in July.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,998 in June to 3,633 in July.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 12,485 in June to 11,478 in July.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 5,791 in June to 6,086 in July.
- **Overall Filings decreased** from 32,343 in June to 31,135 in July.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision decreased** from 2,493 in June to 2,026 in July.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 422 in June to 444 in July.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,611 in June to 21,733 in July.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 691 in June to 702 in July.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,902 in June to 7,725 in July.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 273 in June to 227 in July.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 15.2 in June to 17.3 in July.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,504 in June to 2,253 in July.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation decreased** from 245 in June to 214 in July.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 40 in June to 26 in July.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail



Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days






Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments





Justice Court Filings July 2012




Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

- July 2012





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
