CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – June 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 10,296 in May to 9,944 in June. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,817 in May to 7,732 in June. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in June (5,278) compared to May (5,318). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,134 in May to 2,108 in June. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 314 in May to 289 in June. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) stayed the same** from May (24) to June (24). **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 23.9 to 24.9 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased slightly** from 5.9 to 5.8 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 63 to 59 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from May (2,577) to June (3,082). **Terminations increased** from 2,652 in May to 2,891 in June. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 94%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,532 in May to 10,439 in June. **Filings into RCC increased** in June (1,757) compared to May (1,466). **Filings into EDC increased** from 935 in May to 1,105 in June. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 56 in May to 52 in June. **The Trial Rate** was 1.7%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings increased from May (792) to June (851). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,632 in May to 4,250 in June. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 9,716 in May to 12,991 in June. **Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement Filings increased** from 36,789 in May to 63,846 in June. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from May (4,979) to June (5,595). **Overall Filings increased** from 68,302 in May to 99,942 in June.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased slightly from May (552) to June (559). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 782 in May to 828 in June. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 208 in May to 196 in June. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,316 in May to 30,228 in June. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 818 in May to 808 in June.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 258 in May to 263 in June. **ALOS increased** from 11.7 to 14.8 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 27 in May to 31 in June. **Standard probation decreased** from 3,920 in May to 3,758 in June. **Intensive Probation increased** from 359 in May to 373 in June.


Jail Bookings

Average Daily Jail Population by Type





Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter






Grand Jury Indictments





Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


