CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – June 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 9,686 in May to 9,016 in June.
- **Releases decreased** from 9,718 in May to 9,145 in June.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) decreased** from 8,373 in May to 8,216 in June.
- The **Pretrial ADP decreased** from 6,356 in May to 6,257 in June.
- The **Sentenced ADP decreased** from 1,769 in May to 1,724 in June.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased** from 181 in May to 176 in June.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release decreased** from 26.1 in May to 25.7 in June.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial decreased** from 8.4 in May to 7.2 in June.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced decreased** from 22.6 in May to 21.2 in June.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds increased** slightly from 68.2 in May to 68.9 in June.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,790 in May to 2,531 in June.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,731 in May to 2,315 in June.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 91%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,449 in May to 11,523 in June.
- **Regional Court Center filings decreased** from 1,733 in May to 1,449 in June.
- **Early Disposition Court filings increased** from 756 in May to 842 in June.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 47 in May to 36 in June.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.4%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 626 in May to 691 in June.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,475 in May to 3,175 in June.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,771 in May to 10,193 in June.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 5,141 in May to 5,646 in June.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 27,994 in May to 26,765 in June.


Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 1,608 in May to 1,664 in June.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 441 in May to 444 in June.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,438 in May to 21,690 in June.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 771 in May to 785 in June.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 6,912 in May to 6,791 in June.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 224 in May to 199 in June.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 14.7 in May to 13.4 in June.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,349 in May to 2,295 in June.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation decreased** from 257 in May to 246 in June.
- Monthly **commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 30 in May to 24 in June.




Jail Releases




Jail Bookings and Releases




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Pretrial Average Daily Population




Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population




Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*

Mandays = Count at midnight plus releases


Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Inmates




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates




Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days






Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments





Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population


