CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – March 2009

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 9,989 in February to 11,059 in March. The **Average Daily Population decreased slightly** from 9,056 to 9,039. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in March (6,265) compared to February (6,398). The **Sentenced Population increased** to 2,365 in March compared to 2,238 in February. **Agency Hold Populations decreased** from 359 in February to 345 in March. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** in March from 25.6 days to 26.3 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24.3 to 22.6; while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 61 to 67. **Pretrial ALOS decreased slightly** from 6.6 to 6.3.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings increased from February (2,957) to March (3,508). **Terminations increased** to 3,563 in March from 2,907 in February. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 101.6%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,649 in February to 11,522 in March. **Filings into RCC increased** in March (2,054) compared to February (1,665). **Filings into EDC increased** from 1,061 in February to 1,220 in March. **The Number of Trials Completed jumped** from 80 in February to 101 in March, the highest number on record. **The Trial Rate was 2.9%**.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings increased from February (4,688) to March (5,849). **Overall Filings increased** from February (34,439) to March (34,855).


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from February (607) to March (581), which represents the lowest level since July 2002. **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased slightly**, from 1,058 in February to 1,057 in March, which is the lowest since June 2007. **Electronic Monitoring remained 268**. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision decreased slightly** from (30,148) in February to (29,974) in March; **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision also decreased** from 996 in January to 984 in February to 969 in March, which is the lowest figure since November 2003.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) increased** from 291 in February to 318 in March. ADP is down 16% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS increased** from 10.7 days to 12.4 days. ALOS is down 12% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC increased** from 57 in February to 66 in March. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,309 in February to 4,290 in March. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 466 to 464.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates


Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments





Superior Court Trials Completed




Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Justice Court Filings March 2009


Average monthly dispositions by quarter






Status of Cases After 180 Days

□ Active □ Awaiting sentence □ Terminated




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




