CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – March 2011

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 8,342 in February to 9,548 in March. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,048 in February to 7,181 in March. The **Pretrial Population increased** in March (4,929) compared to February (4,868). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,888 in February to 1,961 in March. The **Agency Hold Population decreased slightly** from 241 in February to 239 in March. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased slightly** from February (23.7) to March (23.3). The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 23.5 to 22.4 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 5.7 to 6.9 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 62.2 to 60 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from February (2,519) to March (2,937). **Terminations increased** from 3,020 in February to 3,394 in March. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 116%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,051 in February to 10,031 in March. **Filings into RCC increased** in March (1,685) compared to February (1,397). **Filings into EDC increased** from 906 in February to 976 in March. The **Number of Trials Completed increased slightly** from 55 in February to 58 in March. The **Trial Rate** was 2%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings increased from February (598) to March (838). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,304 in February to 4,105 in March. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 9,148 in February to 11,502 in March. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from February (3,870) to March (4,181). **Overall Filings increased** from 26,744 in February to 32,037 in March.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from February (581) to March (565). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 945 in February to 994 in March. **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 203 in February to 212 in March. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,111 in February to 29,517 in March. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 803 in February to 812 in March.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 252 in February to 261 in March. **ALOS increased** from 12.3 to 15.4 days. **Standard probation increased slightly** from 3,383 in February to 3,386 in March. **Intensive Probation increased** from 298 in February to 319 in March.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter








Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



Revised FY08 results based on adjustments in iCIS reporting.


Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
