## *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – May 2012*

### Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 8,831 in April to 9,443 in May.
- The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,528 in April to 7,792 in May.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 5,491 in April to 5,698 in May.
- The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,815 in April to 1,881 in May.
- The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 172 in April to 166 in May.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 24.6 in April to 25.1 in May.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 22.5 days in April to 24.2 in May.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial increased** from 6.95 days in April to 7.05 in May.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 71.4 days in April to 68.8 in May.

### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,685 in April to 3,306 in May.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,983 in April to 2,373 in May
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 78%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,251 in April to 11,564 in May.
- **Filings into Regional Court Center increased** from 1,418 in April to 1,601 in May.
- **Filings into Early Disposition Court increased** from 942 in April to 1,166 in May.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 53 in April to 50 in May.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.6%.

### Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 590 in April to 799 in May.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,021 in April to 3,693 in May.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 9,243 in April to 10,451 in May.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 4,786 in April to 5,465 in May.
- **Overall Filings increased** from 26,241 in April to 30,486 in May.

### Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 1,648 in April to 2,069 in May.
- **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 374 in April to 314 in May.
- **Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,844 in April to 21,652 in May.
- **Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 689 in April to 706 in May.
- **Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,999 in April to 7,897 in May.


### Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 250 in April to 285 in May.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 12.1 in April to 14.4 in May.
- **Standard probation decreased** from 2,652 in April to 2,559 in May.
- **Intensive Probation decreased** from 268 in April to 265 in May.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 31 in April to 33 in May.





# Average Daily Jail Population by Type






# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail



# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active      Awaiting sentence      Terminated




# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




# Grand Jury Indictments

# Justice Court Filings May 2012




# Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

■ Oct-Dec 2011





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
