## Criminal Justice System

### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – November 2008*

#### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings** decrease from 11,147 in October to 9,969 in November. The **Average Daily Population** decreased from 9,720 to 9,425. The **Pretrial Population** decreased in November (6,607) compared to October (6,829). The **Sentenced Population** decreased to 2,409 in November compared to 2,447 in October. **Agency Hold Populations** decreased from 388 in October to 362 in November. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS)** increased in November from 27.0 to 28.4 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced** decreased from 25.6 to 24.1; while the **ALOS for Agency Holds** decreased from 61.2 to 59.8. **Pretrial ALOS** decreased from 7.5 to 7.1.

#### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal filings** decreased from October (3,222) to November (2,753), which is the lowest figure since November 2006. **Terminations** decreased to 2,803 in November from 3,948 in October. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 101.8%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory** increased from 11,474 in October to 11,593 in November. **Filings into RCC** decreased in November (1,711) compared to October (2,110). **Filings into EDC** increased from 841 in October to 867 in November. **The Number of Trials Completed** decreased from 77 in October to 62 in November. **The Trial Rate** was 2.3%.

#### Justice Court Filings

**Forcible Detainer Filings** decreased from October (6,550) to November (6,519). **Overall Filings** decreased from October (36,001) to November (34,203).


#### Adult Probation

**Pretrial General Supervision** decreased from October (703) to November (698); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision** decreased, from 1,114 in October to 1,108 in November. **Electronic Monitoring** increased from 251 to 262. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision** increased slightly from (30,186) in October to (30,222) in November; **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision** increased slightly from 995 in October to 1000 in November.


#### Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP)** decreased from 317 in October to 304 in November. ADP is down 13% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS** increased slightly from 12.8 to 13.1 days. ALOS is down 2% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC** decreased from 36 in October to 32 in November. **Standard probation** decreased from 4,314 in October to 4,253 in November. **Intensive Probation** decreased slightly from 466 to 464.




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




## Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances







# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Grand Jury Indictments




# Superior Court Trials Completed



# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



## Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
