CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – November 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 9,012 in October to 8,428 in November.
- The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,203 in October to 8,083 in November.
- The **Pretrial Population decreased** from 6,127 in October to 6,032 in November.
- The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 1,850 in October to 1,807 in November.
- The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 176 in October to 185 in November.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release increased** from 24.6 in Oct. to 26.7 in Nov.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial increased** from 6.7 in October to 7.6 in November.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 22.9 in October to 24.4 in November.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 65.5 in October to 74.6 in November.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,728 in October to 2,192 in November.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,902 in October to 2,416 in November.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 110%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,476 in October to 11,322 in November.
- **Regional Court Center filings decreased** from 1,579 in October to 1,273 in November.
- **Early Disposition Court filings decreased** from 855 in October to 700 in November.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 57 in October to 43 in November.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 719 in October to 548 in November.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,339 in October to 3,015 in November.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 8,722 in October to 8,992 in November.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 5,791 in October to 5,350 in November.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 28,373 in October to 26,040 in November.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 2,107 in October to 2,181 in November.
- **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 431 in October to 419 in November.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,641 in Oct. to 21,610 in Nov.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 660 in Oct. to 663 in Nov.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,601 in Oct. to 7,527 in Nov.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 221 in October to 199 in Nov.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention stayed the same** with 15.3 in October and November.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,442 in October to 2,397 in November.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation decreased** from 235 in October to 226 in November.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 30 in October to 48 in November.



Jail Releases






Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Pretrial Average Daily Population




Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population




Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail At Release




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments





Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population


