CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – November 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 9,102 in October to 8,396 in November.
- **Releases decreased** from 9,432 in October to 8,711 in November.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) decreased** from 8,171 in October to 7,974 in November.
- The **Pretrial ADP decreased** from 6,162 in October to 6,043 in November.
- The **Sentenced ADP decreased** from 1,790 in October to 1,723 in November.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased slightly** from 165 in October to 164 in November.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release decreased slightly** from 27.9 in October to 27.8 in November.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial decreased** from 8.9 in October to 7.9 in November.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced increased** from 23.5 in October to 25.5 in November.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds increased** from 72 in October to 93 in November.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 3,322 in October to 2,346 in November.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,914 in October to 2,261 in November.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 96%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,757 in October to 11,932 in November.
- **Regional Court Center filings decreased** from 1,628 in October to 1,309 in November.
- **Early Disposition Court filings decreased** from 1,356 in October to 809 in November.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 80 in October to 52 in November.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2.2%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 690 in October to 616 in November.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,081 in October to 2,693 in November.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 9,576 in October to 9,040 in November.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 5,928 in October to 5,096 in November.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 26,849 in October to 24,962 in November.


Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 2,073 in October to 2,100 in November.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 531 in October to 573 in November.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,176 in October to 21,153 in November.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision remained the same** as 873 in both October and November.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 6,572 in Oct. to 6,457 in November.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 187 in October to 182 in November.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 13.4 in October to 15.1 in November.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,184 in October to 2,108 in November.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 235 in October to 219 in November.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 23 in October to 12 in November.

Number of Dependency Filings, Juvenile Court




Recidivism Risk Score (RRS / "Proxy") Distribution Among Current Jail Population, 2013:












Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Pretrial Average Daily Population




Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population




Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial and Sentenced Inmates




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates




Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds



Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory



Superior Court Trials Completed




Status of Cases After 180 Days




Disposition of Cases Terminated




Grand Jury Indictments








Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population








Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
