CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – October 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 9,116 in September to 9,012 in October.
- The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,286 in September to 8,203 in October.
- The **Pretrial Population decreased** from 6,239 in September to 6,127 in October.
- The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,812 in September to 1,850 in October.
- The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 185 in September to 176 in October.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 24.9 in September to 24.6 in October.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial decreased** from 7.9 in September to 6.7 in October.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24.0 in September to 22.9 in October.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 66.1 in September to 65.5 in October.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,259 in September to 2,728 in October.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,477 in September to 2,902 in October.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 106.4%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,408 in September to 11,476 in October.
- **Regional Court Center filings increased** from 1,319 in September to 1,579 in October.
- **Early Disposition Court filings increased** from 719 in September to 855 in October.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 45 in September to 57 in October.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2.1%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 765 in September to 719 in October.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,113 in September to 3,339 in October.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,342 in September to 8,722 in October.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 5,869 in September to 5,791 in October.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 28,795 in September to 28,373 in October.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 2,044 in September to 2,107 in October.
- **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 461 in September to 431 in October.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,662 in September to 21,641 in Oct.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 678 in September to 660 in October.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,643 in Sept. to 7,601 in Oct.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 243 in September to 221 in October.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 13.7 in September to 15.3 in October.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation increased** from 2,410 in September to 2,442 in October.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 231 in September to 235 in October.
- Monthly **commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections** stayed the same with 30 in September and October.




Jail Releases




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Pretrial Average Daily Population




Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population




Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail At Release




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

■ Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments



Justice Court Filings October 2012




Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population


