## *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – September 2012*

### Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 9,490 in August to 9,116 in September.
- The **Average Daily Population increased** from 8,224 in August to 8,286 in September.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 6,230 in August to 6,239 in September.
- The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,769 in August to 1,812 in September.
- The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 176 in August to 185 in September.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 24.1 in August to 24.9 in September.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial increased** from 6.6 in August to 7.9 in September.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 23.9 in August to 24.0 in September.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 65 in August to 66.1 in September.

### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,670 in August to 2,259 in September.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,698 in August to 2,477 in September.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 109.7%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,695 in August to 11,408 in September.
- **Filings into the Regional Court Center decreased** from 1,686 in August to 1,319 in September.
- **Filings into the Early Disposition Court decreased** from 740 in August to 719 in September.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 37 in August to 45 in September.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2%.

### Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 834 in August to 765 in September.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,964 in August to 3,113 in September.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 11,619 in August to 10,342 in September.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 6,239 in August to 5,869 in September.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 32,982 in August to 28,795 in September.

### Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 2,014 in August to 2,044 in September.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 445 in August to 461 in September.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 22,369 in August to 21,662 in Sept.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 691 in August to 678 in September.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,663 in August to 7,643 in Sept.


### Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 218 in August to 244 in September.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 15 in August to 13.7 in September.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,497 in August to 2,410 in September.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation decreased** from 234 in August to 231 in September.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 36 in August to 27 in September.






# Jail Releases




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type




# Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




# Sentenced Average Daily Population




# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




# Status of Cases After 180 Days






# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




# Grand Jury Indictments



# Justice Court Filings September 2012




# Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
