

Worksite Flu Shot Events - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Below are some frequently asked questions about the annual worksite flu shot events.

Do I need to be insured under a County-sponsored medical plan in order to participate in a worksite flu shot event?

The worksite flu shot event is conducted for the convenience of Maricopa County employees and their adult dependents who are enrolled in a County-sponsored medical plan.

What do I need to bring to a worksite flu shot event?

Bring your insurance card along with your Maricopa County ID.

Are walk-ins accepted?

Yes, walk-ins are accepted.

Can I call Walgreens Pharmacy for technical assistance in scheduling my flu shot?

Yes, call 602.283.9925.

Is there an electronic consent form I can download and fill out prior to getting my flu shot?

When you schedule your appointment, the Informed Consent for Vaccination form will be available to download from your appointment confirmation page. To expedite the process, bring the completed form with you to your appointment.

What type of flu shot is available?

The trivalent, quadravalent, and high dose flu shots are available. There will be a limited quantity of preservative-free shots available. There is no Flumist available this year because it has only been three percent effective in the past three years and the CDC does not recommend it for this season.

I am allergic to eggs. Will the worksite flu shot events offer an alternative to the egg-based shot?

Where else can I get the flu shot?

If you are enrolled in a County-sponsored medical plan, you can also get your flu shot free at select in-network local area pharmacies, or through your in-network primary care physician.
